The brewery has an established barrel and sour program focusing on traditional and experimental aging methods. Rock Cut is dedicated to quality and to improvement, continually updating recipes and techniques.

Competencies and qualifications:

- Prior experience in breweries, restaurants or other customer service is a plus, but not required
- Knowledge of craft beer and the desire to always learn more
- Ability to communicate clearly with patrons while expressing warmth and energy
- Ability to accept training and to give and to receive feedback to improve both personally and the brewery team
- Ability to take direction, to take initiative and to work in a team environment
- Ability to work 8 to 10 hour shifts while standing for the duration of that time
- Ability to work a variety of shift times, including mornings, evenings, weekends and holidays.

- Must work with accepted personal and business ethic, be diligent, timely and professional
- Must have an awareness of environment (customer needs, work with other employees in tight spaces, be cognisant of personal and others' safety when moving through the brewery)
- Must be at least 21 years of age
